1. Student chooses one:

Two-octave major scale and tonic arpeggio in A^b, B^b, or B.

2. Student chooses one:

Two-octave major scale and tonic arpeggio in E^b, E, or F.

3. Student chooses one. Play both melodic and harmonic versions:

Two-octave minor scale and tonic arpeggio in G^m, D^m, or A^m.

4. Student plays:

Two-octave G chromatic scale. Slur 2 eighth notes.

Bowing for major and minor scales: slur 4 eighth notes.

Bowing for arpeggios: slur 2 eighth notes or 3 triplet eighth notes.
